1. Five times John refers to himself as “the disciple whom Jesus loved.” Read the following verses: John 13:21-23; John 19:25-27; John 20:1,2; John 21:4-7, 19-21. What things define who you are? What are the results of that in your life?

2. In John 13:25, John reclines and places his head on Jesus’ chest. When in your life have you felt the closest to Jesus? How can this help to shape your identity? Read Revelation 2:1-5. What are the things that you did when you felt closest to Jesus?

3. Read I John 4:13-18. Are you motivated more by God’s love or by fear? What are you most fearful of in your life? Pray that you can rest in God’s perfect love that eliminates that fear.
