1. If you could travel forward in time in a time machine where would you go and why? How do you think having this information would affect you when you returned?
2. What is the purpose of prophecy in the bible? Specifically, what is the purpose of Daniel 11? Would it encourage the readers or discourage them? Why or why not?
3. Read Daniel 11:30-35. What persecution is this referring to? What happens to the faithful? Why do you think God allowed this to happen to His people? What can we learn from this time in history to prepare us for the future?
4. Many believe that the person described in verses 36-45 is the same as the "little horn" in Daniel 7. Look at both scriptures and make as many comparisons as you can. Read 2 Thessalonians 2:3-12; 1 John 2:18 and Revelations 13:11-18. Make a list of things we know about this coming antichrist.
5. Read Daniel 11:36-45. Look for words or phrases that are an encouragement to believers who will be alive during this time. What would you say to them if you could travel forward in time and have a conversation with them?
6. What takeaways are there for you and your group from Daniel 11?
