Who can join the 60+ ministry?

Our ministry is open to all seniors looking for a supportive community to share in their faith journey. Whether you are a long-time church member or new to the community, we welcome you to join us.

Who is a "Senior"?

Technically, a senior is anyone 55+ (qualifies for senior discounts), whereas the generally accepted age that means someone is a "senior" and eligible for government benefits (Social Security, Medicare) is 65+. 60+ Ministry's desire is to minister to anyone who is retired, semi-retired, still working, or just considers themselves as a "senior" no matter whether someone is 55, 65, 75, 85+.
